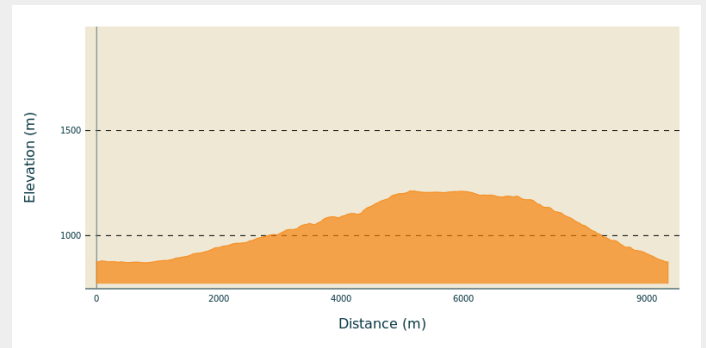

Starting at "***Saint-Etienne du Valdonnez***", go to "***La Fage***" via "***Gorges du Bramont***", "***Passerelle du Bramont***" and "***La Borie***". At "***La Fage***", return to "***Saint-Etienne du Valdonnez***" via "***Bassy***", "***Chemin de Bassy***".

Access

From Florac, to the Col de Montmirat pass on the RN 106. Continue on the RN 106, then turn right onto the D 25 to St-Étienne-du-Valdonnez.

From Mende, take the RN 88 to Balsièges and turn left onto the RN 106; before Molines turn left onto the D 125 to reach St-Étienne-du-Valdonnez.
