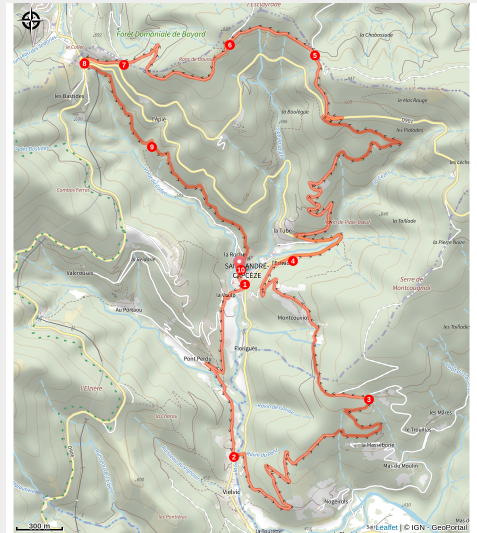


# La Régordane

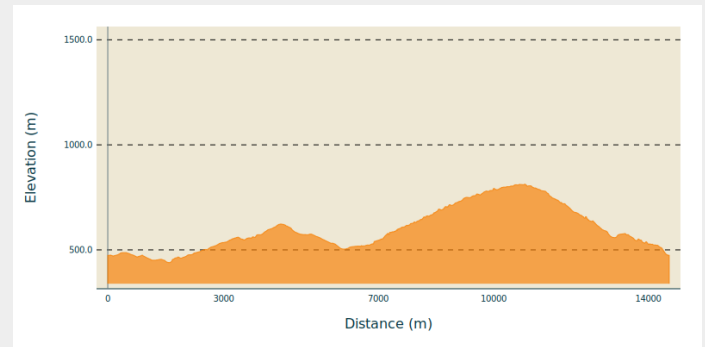

Signposts will guide you all along this route. In the description below, the signposted place names and/or directions are given in **bold italics** between quotation marks :

From “**SAINT-ANDRÉ-CAPCÈZE**”, walk to “**Vielvic**” via :

1. “**L'Estrade**”,
2. “**Vielvic**”. At “**Vielvic**”, turn left to “**Nidaucel**”.
3. At “**Nidaucel**”, turn left to “**Saint-André-Capcèze**”.
4. At “**Saint-André-Capcèze**”, turn right to “**Le Collet**” via :
5. “**Plo des Ayres**”,
6. “**L'Esclayrade**”,
7. “**Forêt de Bayard**”,
8. “**Le Collet**”. At “**Le Collet**” turn left to return to “**SAINT-ANDRÉ-CAPCÈZE**” via :
9. “**L'Apié**”,
10. “**La Roche**”.
